NARCAN® Nasal Spray is a prescription medicine used for the treatment of a known or suspected opioid overdose emergency with signs of breathing problems and severe sleepiness or not being able to respond. NARCAN® Nasal Spray is to be given right away and does not take the place of emergency medical care. Get emergency medical help right away after giving the first dose of NARCAN® Nasal Spray, even if the person wakes up. NARCAN® Nasal Spray is safe and effective in children for known or suspected opioid overdose.



PEOPLE AT HIGHER RISK OF OPIOID OVERDOSE

People who:

- Use prescription opioids for chronic pain, especially higher doses
- Use opioids in combination with other sedating substances (like benzodiazepines or alcohol)
- Use opioids and have certain medical conditions such as HIV, liver disease, lung disease, or depression
- Inject opioids

People with:

- Access to opioids (including prescription opioids)
- An opioid dependence, particularly following reduced tolerance
- A prior history of opioid overdose

According to the CDC, opioids were involved in 49,860 overdose deaths in 2019 (70.6% of all drug overdose deaths).
